ALCOHOLIC LIQUORS*

Sec. 4-1. Prohibited consumption.

No alcoholic liquors may be consumed under the following conditions:

- (1) It shall be unlawful hereafter for any person to consume alcoholic liquors while on city streets or rights-of-way within the city while in or out of the vehicle or other mode of transport.
- (2) On any public or private parking lot while in or out of the vehicle or other mode of transport.
- (3) On the premises of any business establishment not regularly licensed to sell alcoholic liquors, including drive-ins, while in or out of the vehicle or other mode of transport.
- (4) While in or on the main stream of the AuSable River within the city limits.

Deviation from the foregoing rules may be granted by the city council on application in case of special events. (Ord. No. 72-6, 6-12-1972)
