A. Thomas Steffen PUD

Member Forbes stated she liked the addition of the washer & dryer in units. Member Doe stated he liked the layout with smaller units towards the back. He asked Mr. Steffen about the foundations of the units. Mr. Steffen replied that the foundations would be poured shallow, frost protected foundations. Mr. Steffen emailed final site plan with revisions on May 19th. Chair Hehir informed Mr. Steffen he needed to update the HOA rules and regulations and add his contact information on the first page since he is the owner. Member Rosin asked when he planned on breaking ground. Mr. Steffen stated he would like to put up one unit to get the word out and get a feel for the interest in the community. He plans to demo existing structure before then. His goal is to have first up in spring and hopes to be done by end of summer. Chair Hehir informed Mr. Steffen that no phase plan was needed if completed within 1 year. Mr. Steffen stated he would need an approval to move forward and acquire permanent financing from mortgage holders but does have building financing in place currently. Podjaske suggested to Members a conditional approval in order for Mr. Steffen to secure funding. Mr. Steffen will need to submit phasing and timeline plan prior to initial construction. Chair Hehir asked what exterior material will be used. Member Rosin and Podjaske suggested board & batten, cedar shake and/or cement board as shown in previous model pictures for a clean look and each have individual character. Chair Hehir asked for a list of interested buyers, building materials and list of deviations be included in the phasing plan.

Podjaske informed Members of the added section (3.6.1 15) for vehicle charging stations as they are now becoming more common but did not fall under an existing category currently. Members were in agreeance and will hold a Public Hearing during regular meeting on October 20, 2020 at 6pm. Notice will be sent to the newspaper no later than September 25, 2020 for following week newspaper.

IX. Zoning Administrators Report

Zoning Officer Podjaske gave a verbal report. He stated the Sawmill project was a go. That EGLE approved \$554,000 in more grant funding but the structure will be reduced to a 3-story from a 5-story due to lack of funding. A new site plan will need to be submitted because of the 10%+ change. Demo to start the end of October. New construction to start in the spring and completed by end of 2021.
