

CITY PARK RULES

“THE FOLLOWING RULES AND REGULATIONS SHALL GOVERN ALL MUNICIPAL PARK LAND IN THE CITY OF GRAYLING.

ON SUCH LAND, NO UNAUTHROIZED PERSON SHALL:

1. Cut, injure, deface, remove or disturb any tree, shrub, building, fence, bench, table or other structure, apparatus or property; pick, cut or remove any shrub, bush or flower; or mark or write upon any building, fence, bench or other structure.
2. Make or kindle an open fire, except in areas provided for that purpose.
3. Sell, offer or solicit for sale any goods or merchandise without a permit.
4. Remain, stay or loiter in the Park between the hours of 10:00pm and 6:00am the following day except as allowed by a permit or for events of charitable, civic or governmental organizations.
5. Post, paste or affix any placard, notice or sign within the Park without a permit.
6. Operate any motor vehicle or off-road motor vehicle on any paved walkway, except electric vehicles to assist the physically handicapped.
7. Bring into, possess or consume any alcoholic beverage and/or illicit drug while in the Park.
8. Use or possess fireworks, explosives or devices capable of launching a projectile.
9. Make any sound or noise generated by a group, person or device which is excessive or obscene, including such devices as radios, loud speakers, public address systems or similar devices unless the same are permitted in writing.
10. Domesticated or pet animals are not allowed in the Park unless accompanied by their owners and controlled on a leash not more than 6 feet long. All animal excrement shall immediately be placed in litter receptacles by the pet owner or ward.
11. Deposit or discard, either in open or in designated trash receptacles, any trash, garbage or waste not generated by lawful activities in the Park.
12. Adults are responsible for accompanying their minor children 10 years of age or younger.
13. Use of the Park is at the user's risk.
14. All City Playgrounds are Tobacco and Drug Free.
