SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD

JOB DESCRIPTION

Rate of Pay: Negotiable

General Summary

School Crossing Guard will work 1 (one) hour in the morning and 1 (one) hour in the afternoon ensuring that students safely cross the street at the specific school crossing location. Work is performed on days school is in session.

Required Minimum Qualifications

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
- Must possess the ability to safely perform the job functions of a School Crossing Guard.
- Must provide fingerprints and have an acceptable criminal history record as determined by the Grayling Police Department.
- Must successfully complete a pre-employment physical and drug screen prior to hire.

Essential Job Functions

- Ensure the safe crossing of students at specific school crossing locations following established guidelines and using good judgment.
- Report safety violations of motorists and pedestrians.
- Communicate and interact effectively and professionally with students, parents, school personnel, city employees and others.

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- Follow all applicable safety rules and regulations.
- Be dependable and meet acceptable attendance requirements at all times.

Physical Demands

- Periods of standing and walking outdoors in all types of weather conditions wearing appropriate safety gear.
- Stop traffic by holding a stop sign.

Tasks

- Direct or escort pedestrians across streets, stopping traffic as necessary.
- Guide or control vehicular or pedestrian traffic
- Monitor traffic flow to locate safe gaps through which pedestrians can cross streets.
- Communicate traffic and crossing rules and other information to students and adults.
- Direct traffic movement or warn of hazards, using signs and hand signals.
- Report unsafe behavior of children to school officials.
- Record license numbers of vehicles disregarding traffic signals, and report infractions to appropriate authorities.
