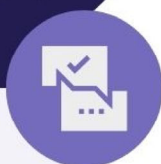


LOOKING FOR A NEW OPTION TO ATTRACT AND RETAIN STAFF ?

The MI Tri-Share Child Care Program is designed to make child care affordable for Michigan's working parents while also helping Michigan employers offer a highly desirable benefit that improves employee recruitment and retention.

Through MI Tri-Share, the cost of an employee's child care is shared equally among the employer, the employee and the State of Michigan - an even three-way split

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EMPLOYER REQUIREMENTS AND CONSIDERATIONS

- Offer the MI Tri-Share program to one or more employees with dependent children between 0-17 years old.
- Agree to cover 33% of participating employees' child care costs.
- Confirm employee wage information, if requested.
- Collect employee payments
- Submit employer and employee payments via ACH.
- Allow for flexibility as family situations and needs vary.
